Monday 6 <sup>th</sup> June	Jefferey Hill	SD640402 PR3 2TT	Park in rough layby opposite Cardwell House. Exploring Longridge Fell. <b>Some Climbing.</b>	19.00

Monday 1 <sup>st</sup> Aug	Fishwick River Ribble	SD554287 PR26 9JQ	Park behind The Shawes Arms. Exploring The River Ribble looking for Kingfisher & Otter.	19.00
Monday 8 <sup>th</sup> Aug	Farington Moss	SD523231 PR26 7QN	Park on the old section of Longmeanygate in Leyland opposite Hugh Lane. This walk takes us over the unique landscape of Farington Moss.	19.00
Monday 15 <sup>th</sup> Aug	Brinscall Moor	SD627213 PR6 8QR	Park at Brinscall Baths, Lodge Bank. Exploring Wheelton Plantation and Brinscall Moor to listen for Wood Warbler. <b>Some Climbing</b>	19.00
Monday 22 <sup>nd</sup> Aug	Croston Moss	SD468181 PR26 9JQ	Park at Isle of Man Bridge on Meadow Lane A581. Exploring the habitat at the top of Croston Moss.	19.00
