20 <sup>th</sup> May	Freckleton Naze	SD434287 PR4 1HA	Park at The Ship PH Freckleton off Bunker Street. Walking to the famous Naze that overlooks the Rivers Ribble & Douglas.
27 <sup>th</sup> May	Mawdesley Moss	SD493149 L40 2QP	Park at The Red Lion PH Mawdesley on New Street. Exploring the ancient Mawdesley Moss.
3 <sup>rd</sup> June	Broughton Barton	SD524350 PR3 5HE	Park at The Broughton Inn. Exploring the habitat between Broughton & Barton.
10 <sup>th</sup> June	Longton Marsh	SD460241 PR4 5LH	Park at the bottom of Station Road. Much Hoole just off the large roundabout. Exploring the River Douglas & Little Hoole Moss.
17 <sup>th</sup> June	Samlesbury Bezza	SD603302 PR5 0UL	Park at The Trafalger Hotel. Samlesbury. Exploring The Dean Lane area of Ancient Salmesbury
24 <sup>th</sup> June	Ulnes Walton Stannings Folly	SD502217 PR26 6TD	Park on Ridley Lane just before Cocker Bar Bridge. Looking at Ulnes Walton & Bretherton Moss.
1 <sup>st</sup> July	Stanworth	SD628242 PR6 8BL	Park in layby opposite The Hoghton Arms. Hoghton on A674 Exploring the Stanworth Area and returning via the Canal.
8 <sup>th</sup> July	Rufford. Croston Moss	SD464156 L40 1SB	Park on the east end of Church Road. Rufford. Exploring the habitat of Croston Moss & Croston Finney.
15 <sup>th</sup> July	Abbey Village Roddlesworth	SD642223 PR6 8EA	Park on Dole Lane opposite The Hare & Hounds PH. Looking at the Roddlesworth area.
22 <sup>nd</sup> July	Carr House Green Common	SD474370 PR4 0TE	Park on Woods Lane. Inskip or The Derby Arms PH Looking the unique habitat of Carr House Green Common.
29 <sup>th</sup> July	Farington Moss	SD528243 PR26 6AP	Park behind the Centurian Tank on the Penwortham Bypass B5253 Exploring the environs of the ancient Farington Moss.
5 <sup>th</sup> Aug	Bretherton Moss	SD502217 PR26 6TD	Park on Ridley Lane on the left before Cocker Bar Bridge. Exploring Bretherton Moss.
12 <sup>th</sup> Aug	Hollingshead Hall	SD665191 BL7 8BG	Park on Crookfield Rd (sp Tocholes) just oppf Belmont Road. Walking to Hollingshead Hall to look at the famous Wishing Well
9 <sup>th</sup> Aug	Bretherton Eyes	SD470203 PR26 9AS	Park at the top of Eyes Lane. Walking to Red Bridge.
