Sunday 29 <sup>th</sup> Oct	Dean Clough Reservoir	SD710336 BB6 8DU	Park opposite The Lord Nelson PH in York Village. (Some Climbing involved) Looking at Dean Clough Reservoir and the surrounding countryside
Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> Nov	Midge Hall Moss	SD513231 PR26 6TD	Park on a section of Longmeanygate adjacent to the new roundabouts. Exploring the farmland around Midge Hall.
Sunday 17 <sup>th</sup> Dec	White Coppice Brinscall	SD619190 PR6 9DE	Park The Cricket Ground. White Coppice. (Christmas Walk. With pub visit after) Walking to Brinscall looking at the habitat in this unique valley.
Sunday 28 <sup>th</sup> Jan	Churchtown Nateby	SD487430 PR3 0HQ	Park at Kirkland Maemorial Hall on junction of A6/A586 Walking to Nateby looking at the habitat between the two villages.
Sunday 25 <sup>th</sup> Feb	Croston Moss	SD485192 PR269RF	Park on the access lane to Twin Lakes adjacent to a football pitch on the left. Exploring Croston Moss.
Sunday 31 <sup>st</sup> Mar	Brincall Moor Soloman's Temple	SD627213 PR6 8QU	Park at Brinscall Baths on Lodge Lane. (Some Climbing involved) Climbing up through Wheulton Plantation and onto Brinscall Moor.
Sunday 28 <sup>th</sup> April	Rigg Lane. Birk Bank Littledale	SD526604 LA2 9EJ	Park in the Rigg Lane car park 1 mile north of Quernmore. (Some Climbing) Exploring Littledale and Birk Bank.
Sunday 26 <sup>th</sup> May	Stocks Reservoir Black House	SD737560 BB7 4TS	Park on the Causeway. Stocks Reservoir. (Some Climbing) Walking south along the Reservoir. Return via Ten Acre Hill & Black House.
